AU3 RIVERINE COMMUNITY PARK

Community of AU3 is currently involved in developing a small riverine park which will serve as a platform to instil river awareness into the communities surrounding the area.

The main objective of the Park is to:

- to instill a sense of ownership of the river
- to forge partnerships with local communities to protect the river
- to beautify and turn the river bank into a community park

Sense of ownership cannot be achieved if the government plans and designs the park alone. Only when the local stakeholders are actively involved planning, in the construction and maintenance of the Park will there be a strong sense of ownership, which then will ensure the sustainability of the Park.

Prior to completion of the Park, AU3 community will be building a 'test patch' with help from PAG Consult Sdn Bhd. The park design will focus on simplicity and be made to the whole stretch for the community to improve in the long run.

The design for the park aims to attract different groups from the communities. The necessary aspects of the park include playground for children, herb garden for housewives and

passive exercise tools for youths. Space allocation for future improvements by the community such as placement of gazebo and community
