

ESTABLISHMENT OF RIVER CARE AND ENVIRONMENT CENTRE

Local communities residing in the upper stream of Klang river will soon enjoy another education facility developed under River of Life Project.

The River Care and Environment Centre (RCEC) will be established on a stretch of DID river reserve land adjacent to Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan (Tamil) Taman Melawati, across the river from Riverview Kemensah. The location is strategic as some facilities such as Gazebo and walkway have been previously built in the area, as well as its proximity to three schools that are active in river monitoring and waste recycling activities under ROLPOP.

A path connecting Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan (Tamil) Taman Melawati and the river will also be built near the RCEC with the assistance from DID Gombak.

RCEC will also be the second open classroom education site which was earlier proposed at Medan Selera Taman Melawati. RCEC will be the resource centre for the polluted site and will be furnished with the River Monitoring tools and also materials to assist on the River Auditing as well as equipped with Environmental Education information materials. The RCEC will be established as ROLPOP Community hub and the focal point for Community

Enhancement on River Education and Monitoring.
